MINUTES (for approval) QC P25 INTERGOVERNMENTAL ADVISORY GROUP WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 26, 2021, 2:00 P.M.

Chair Hart called the meeting to order at 2:01 P.M.

Roll call was completed.

Linda Frederiksen motioned to approve the meeting minutes from the September 29th meeting. Steve Knorrek seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion passes.

Tracey Sanders motioned to approve the meeting minutes from the November 17th meeting. Steve Knorrek seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion passes.

Linda Frederiksen motioned to approve the meeting minutes from the December 15th meeting. Tracey Sanders seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion passes.

Project Update Discussion – Advised that there were about 50 open tickets left to be taken care of between T-Steele Construction and RACOM before the project can be completed. RACOM mentioned that there are generator issues at all tower sites. They mentioned that they are getting alarms when the generator is running and unable to acknowledge them remotely. Technicians are going out to the sites daily to check these alarms. T-Steele Construction is in contact with Generator Company and hoping that a firmware update will solve the issues. There will be more information related to this issue discussed at the weekly project call. Cameras are installed and up and running at all sites.

30 Day Burn-in update – Discussed what agencies participated and what agencies are currently on the system. Advised that all of Rock Island Sheriff Department and Coal Valley P.D. are working off the system. East Moline and Moline have a few of their members working off the new radio system. Scott County Sheriff Department has their staff on the radio system.



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BDA Update – After the in building testing back in December there were a few buildings that didn't pass. BDA's will need to be installed to help with radio coverage in those buildings. Rock Island County has received proposals for Moline Police Department from RACOM. Chair Hart advised RIPD can reuse an existing BDA with updated programming for P25. Rock Island Co. S.O. is still waiting final BDA design and cost proposals. Scott County is waiting on proposals for Davenport PD, Scott County Courthouse & Jail, and Scott County Admin building. RACOM advised it would be an additional 6-8 weeks for delivery and installation.

Fleet Map Update – Tracey Sanders advised that some of the Volunteer Fire Departments have a few changes that need to be made. Will get those completed and turned over to RACOM. RACOM advised that they have the most up to date forms minus those changes.

Linda Frederiksen motioned to approve the request of service for the following agencies – Coal Valley PD, Durant Police, Durant Fire, Durant Ambulance, CP Police Service, Scott County FSS, Arconic Fire Brigade, and Bettendorf Public Works/Transit. Steve Seiver seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion approved for those agencies to allow access to the radio system.

During the public comment portion of the meeting. The group held a discussion about Bettendorf Fire getting ready to transition to USDD Phoenix dispatching. Rock Island County advised that their fire departments are getting ready to install and transition their fire departments to USDD Phoenix dispatching.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 23, 2022, at 2:00 P.M.

Moved by Shawn Roth to adjourn. Seconded by Tracey Sanders. Meeting adjourned at 2:48 P.M. All Ayes.
